THE BREED STANDARD OF THE PYGMY GOATS (summary)

The Pygmy Goat is genetically small, cobby, and compact. Full-barrelled and well-muscled, the body circumference in relation to height and weight is proportionately greater than that of other breeds. Mature animals measure between 16 and 23 inches at the withers. Head and legs are short relative to body length. Genetic hornlessness is considered a disqualifying fault. However, disbudded (dehorned) or horned goats are acceptable.

Preferred colors range from white through gray and black in a predominately grizzled (agouti) pattern. Muzzle, forehead, eyes and ears are accented in lighter tones. Front and rear hoofs and cannons (socks) are black, as are the crown and dorsal stripe or martingale. Random markings are acceptable in limited amounts and characteristic locations. Coat length and density vary with climate, making the Pygmy Goat equally at home in the desert or the northern tundra.
